FOR KIDS:

- [A walking stick from outside to be their rod.](#) Make sure it has no sharp edges or splinters. *If you cannot get a stick from outside, grab the broom stick and wrap it in*

crumpled up brown paper from opened up shopping bags to make it look like tree bark.
(PLEASE HAVE THE STAFF READY TO GO WITH THE COSTUME).

- **5 paper bags of any size** to crumble up during the story and make into stones/ rocks. You can also use **manila paper from a dollar tree.**
- **2 cans or 2 filled, 16 oz water bottles** (personal size) to do the strength challenge of holding it up for 1 minute.
- **Items to dress up like a Bible character.** Look for ideas online or use:
Headdress: a towel or scarf and a something like a piece of rope for a head tie
Outfit: a big t-shirt that can fit like a dress & something to tie around your waist. They can also put their bathrobe over the mega t-shirt, but leave it open. Use a bed sheet to make a costume if needed.
Use your imagination! **It is ok to practice dressing like a Bible character in advance or have an adult around to help kids get into character for this story.**
